When emailing to show committee remember to include:

- 1. Entry Form 1 form for each rider/horse pairing. If rider is showing more than one horse, please fill out a 2<sup>nd</sup> form
- 2. Proof of Liability insurance for all exhibitors and equines entered.
- 3. Horse show release form signed by Parent/Guardian for all juniors (under 18)

#### Show Rules (Applicable to Friday Horse Show)

- THIS SHOW WILL BE FOLLOWING THE EQUINE CANADA'S RULES FOR BREED, DRIVING, HUNTER / JUMPER AND WESTERN SHOWS.
   IN ADDITION TO THE RULES LISTED BELOW.
- Horses/ponies are not to be grazed, ridden or driven on the beach, soccer field and/or fair grounds. Only on the lower portion of the track and show ring is permitted. See Map.
- 3. Any person interfering with the Judge(s)/Officials/Stewarts or uses contemptuous/abusive languages or damages property will have to forfeit rights to premiums they are entitled to. Protests must be written, signed and mailed with a \$50.00 deposit to the horse show secretary within 48 hours.
- 4. In case of dispute, final decision will be up to the horse show committee. The Horse Show Committee will not be held responsible for any accident, damage or loss to exhibitors, animals, spectators, vehicles or other property at the fair.
- 5. Any entries received the week before the show will be charged a late fee of \$10.00, and entries made the day of the show will be charged an \$25.00 fee.
- 6. Please park vehicles in designated parking areas. See map below
- 7. Junior Exhibitors are 18 years and under as of December 31st of that year.
- 8. Entry Forms must be signed by all exhibitors and a parent or guardian must sign a Junior Exhibitor Release.
- 9. At this show a horse is over 14.3 hands and a pony is under 14.2 hands
- 10. Animals must be kept under control and never left unattended.
- 11. If for any reason a horse/pony becomes loose, the show will come to a halt until said horse/pony is apprehended and under control again.
- 12. All events start on schedule. Exhibitors and horse/pony must be in proper attire, equipment and ready five (5) minutes prior to their class. Failure to do so will result in a disqualified. Please inform if an exhibitor will not be competing in the designated classes, prior to the class being called. We acknowledge that classes may conflict. In this case, we refrain from switching classes (consideration of fellow exhibitors); but will gladly hold the gate for three (3) minutes. Please inform a Horse Show Official or Stewart should you require a hold.
- 13. Any exhibitor who falls, dismounts or cannot control their horse/pony in the show ring is an instant disqualification of that class. This also includes lining for ribbons. Continued offences will result in said exhibitor being excused from the show in its entirety and forfeiting all prize money.
- 14. All under saddle exhibitors must wear proper footwear with a heel.
- 15. An ASTM approved riding helmet must be worn by all junior exhibitors (both English, Western and Driving/Hitch), while under saddle and warm-up ring. Showmanship is excluded.
- 16. Any exhibitor under the age of six (6) years of age in that year, must wear an ASTM approved helmet at all times when around, handling or working with any pony or horse. As well as, this exhibitor must be accompanied by an individual 16 years or older at times when around, handling or working with any pony or horse.
- 17. Tack checks will be performed at random. These checks maybe performed prior to entering the ring by the Stewart or during class line up by the Judge of the Day. Both occurrences will require all Exhibitors to drop their bridle and show their bit to ensure it falls into the rules and regulations of bits. If an exhibitor requires assistance during any time of a tack check, their coach or trainer can come to their aid.
- 18. All tack and harness must fit correctly.
- 19. No running martingales in any over fences' classes. Standing martingale is allowed.
- 20. In all "English" classes, No flashes, drop nose or grackle (figure 8) nose bands are allowed.
- 21. Prohibited Bits, Mouth Pieces and bridles are as follows: No bits are allowed with the following mouth pieces: corkscrew, twisted wire, waterford, double or triple mouth pieces, pronged, bike chain, mule, chain. No Bits that have gag action or is a gag bit. No combination bits (bit and hackamore combination). No bitless, hackamore or bosal bridles, double bridles, hackamore or bosal bridles.
- 22. Only curbs that are allowed are single or double chained and leather. No Exhibitor is allowed to ride/drive a horse or pony in a curb bit that is not a properly adjusted.
- 23. The use of lip chains is prohibited on the show grounds.
- 24. All Exhibitors must stay in their age or skill set divisions, no crossing over or entering other classes is allowed. Lead-line exhibitors are not allowed to go into any walk-trot classes or walk-trot exhibitors cannot go into walk-trot-canter classes and vice versa. Junior Exhibitors are not allowed in an open class and vice versa. Unless stated otherwise.
- 25. Warm-Up Over Fences: One (1) round only per Rider (not to be Judged) from 6:30 am to 8:30 am. FRIDAY CLASSES ONLY!
- 26. All patterns including Showmanship and fences will be released that day of the show.
- 27. All limit classes have been cancelled for this year's event but may be brought back for future shows


PLEASE NOTE: All participants are expected to be present in warm up ring 10 min prior to their class. We will hold the gate if tack change is required between classes.

#### GENEREAL RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR THE MERRICKVILLE FAIR

- 1. Entries are accepted on M.A.S. forms only (provided below). One form per exhibitor/Horse
- 2. The Directors will do their utmost to procure the most competent judges in each of the classes. If an exhibitor is dissatisfied with any decision of such judges, they must immediately enter a written protest with the Secretary against such decision. The Directors shall inquire into the written protest at once and their decision shall be final.
- 3. No persons will be allowed to interfere with the judges while judging is in progress.
- 4. A lone entry in a class/section need not necessarily be awarded a prize.
- 5. Livestock and all articles for competition must be entered in the name of the owner. Failure to observe this rule will result in either forfeiture of an awarded prize or in no prize being awarded at all.
- 6. All persons obtaining prizes fraudulently shall forfeit all goods or monies awarded.
- 7. All exhibitors are expected to conform to safety standards while on the grounds and may be asked to leave if endangering the safety and well-being of any person or livestock.
